REGISTRATION OF PRIVATE CANDIDATES FOR THE OCTOBER/NOVEMBER 2024 PEARSON EDEXCEL INTERNATIONAL EXAMINATIONS

1.0 Registration for the Pearson Edexcel International Examinations for the **October/November 2024 series** is now open. Please note the following registration dates for various examination categories:

- 1.1 International Advanced Level (IAL) – **22nd July 2024 to 23rd August 2024** (October Series)
- 1.2 International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) – **12th August 2024 to 6th September 2024** (November Series)
- 1.3 iLower Secondary and iPrimary exams – **22nd July 2024 to 23rd August 2024** (October Series)

Kindly note that submitting a registration request after the deadline will result in LATE FEES being charged for both The Kenya National Examinations Council and Pearson Edexcel International.

2.0 Requirements:

2.1 Kenyan citizens Candidates Must:

- 2.1.1 Seek authorization from the Chief Executive Officer of the Kenya National Examinations Council to sit for the examinations.
- 2.1.2 Have both an original and a photocopy of your National ID or Passport.

NB: Please note that Birth Certificate will not be accepted as Identification document.

2.2 Foreign Nationals Candidates Must:

- 2.2.1 Submit both originals and certified photocopies of their Passports or Alien IDs.
- 2.2.2 Have passports with an entry visa, from the Department of Immigration Services valid for the entire duration of the examination.

- 2.3** In addition to the identity credentials, all candidates must provide two passport-sized photos.

Uhuru na Kazi Building, next to State House, 4th Floor, Room 11.
- 3.2 Eldoret:** Sub-County Director of Education (Turbo),
County Commissioners Building, Oloo Street.
- 4.0** Candidates are required to make **two separate fees** deposits to the banks listed below, one in Pounds for the Pearson-Edexcel International Examinations fees and one in Kenyan Shillings for the KNEC registration and administration fees, and submit deposit slips to respective registration venue.
